Dr. J.A. Pagán is the founding instructor of The Institute for Intellectual Formation & Skeptical Inquiry (Ft. Wayne, IN). Prior to his current profession, he served our nation as a member of the U.S. Army Special Operations Forces (1995-2000). His M.Div. and Ph.D. degrees were completed at Concordia Theological Seminary (2008; 2011). During his dissertation research, he also explored questions on the intersection of science and religion at Princeton Theological Seminary (2009-11). In addition to his work at the Institute, Pagán is also a graduate school professor, business consultant, and author. His most recent publication, Paul and the Resurrection: Testing the Apostolic Testimony (2020), combines the analytic tools of history and philosophy to evaluate competing explanations of Paul's belief in the risen Jesus.

Rev. Paul Dare has served as a parish pastor for more than 20 years. With a love of Christian education for all ages and an engaging style of teaching, leading Bible studies are the highlight of his work week.
